In countries where bribery is common, progress on the Millennium Development Goals is slower, depriving people of even the most basic services.*

MORE THAN 60%

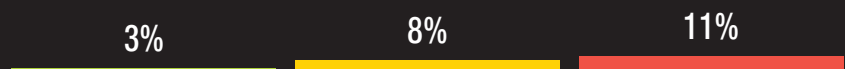
WOMEN DYING IN CHILD BIRTH

Average maternal mortality rate per 100,000 live births in 2010.



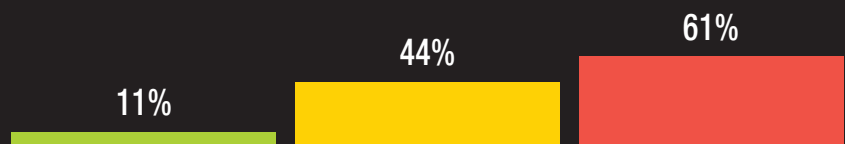
YOUNG PEOPLE WHO CAN'T READ
